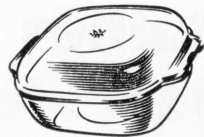

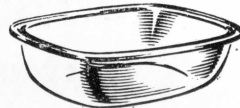

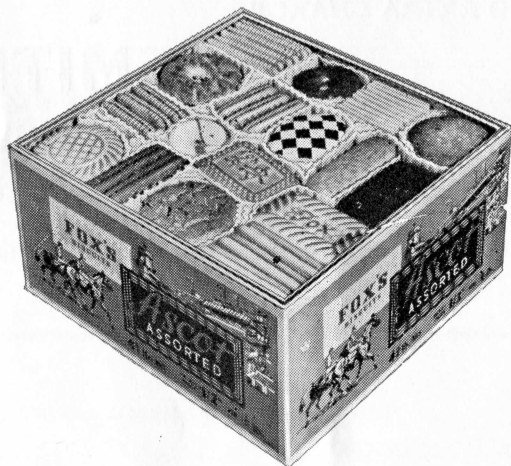

THE STORY

SET in the reign of King Henry VIII, the Tower of London holds the gallant Colonel Fairfax, sentenced to death for sorcery.

To Sergeant Meryll and his daughter, Phoebe, it is unthinkable that the "handsomest head in England" should be laid on the block. Fairfax asks his friend, the Lieutenant of the Tower, for a last boon. Before his execution he wishes to marry—anyone—the first that comes, in order to thwart his kinsman who has charged him with sorcery and who will inherit his estate if he dies unmarried.

The choice falls on Elsie Maynard, a strolling player, who, with Jack Point, works the fairs singing and dancing. For a hundred crowns she agrees to marry Fairfax.

Meanwhile, Sergeant Meryll and Phoebe try to save Fairfax's life. Leonard Meryll arrives, a newly-appointed Yeoman of the Guard whom no one knows, and agrees to let Fairfax take his place. The key of the cell is obtained by Phoebe from the Head Goaler, Wilfred Shadbolt, and Fairfax becomes a Yeoman.

When execution time arrives Fairfax's cell is found to be empty. This is a bitter blow to Jack Point for he had hoped to marry Elsie. He offers to qualify Shadbolt as a jester if he will swear that he shot Fairfax while trying to escape.

Fairfax, masquerading as a Yeoman, discovers that Elsie is his mysterious bride. He makes love to her and although she repulses him it is clear that she loves him. At this point Shadbolt declares that he has shot Fairfax but this ruse is discovered when Leonard Meryll re-appears bringing a pardon for Fairfax.

There is a happy ending for Elsie and Fairfax but Jack Point sings his last song, the "Song of the Merryman, moping mum, who sighed for the love of his ladye."

First produced at the Savoy Theatre in 1888, the accompanist at rehearsals was the young Henry J. Wood. In his memoirs he says that this was Sullivan's favourite opera, for he felt he had achieved in it some of his finest work.
